A 10 day study abroad program in Europe:

The study abroad package includes:

Day 1 >> Sun.:

- Flight to Zurich, Switzerland (not included in the package price; optional: group flights can be arranged upon request)

Day 2 >> Mon.: (Zurich – Lucerne - Engelberg)

- Arrival at Zurich Airport
- Transfer by private bus from the airport to the Engelberg with a stop-over in Lucerne
- Free time for some lunch at the city center of Lucerne...
- Guided tour of the Hergiswil Glasi in Lucerne to learn more about glass blowing...
- 4 nights in twin bedded rooms with shared bathrooms incl. breakfast at the 3-star Hotel Europe in Engelberg
- Welcome Dinner at Hotel Europe

Day 3 >> Tues.: (Lucerne)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Roundtrip train ticket Engelberg – Lucerne (travel time approx. 1 hour one-way)
- Guided walking tour of Lucerne to learn more about this Swiss city...
- Visit to a Swiss bakery in the afternoon
- Afterwards, free time to explore Lucerne on your own...

Day 4 >> Wed.: (Engelberg)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Transfer by private bus during the day
- Visit to the Engelberg cheese factory in the morning incl. cheese tasting
- Free afternoon to explore Engelberg on your own...

Day 5 >> Thurs.: (Lucerne)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Transfer by private bus during the day
- Visit to a culinary school near Lucerne in the morning
- Visit to a Swiss brewery in the afternoon incl. beer tasting
- Afterwards, free time to explore Lucerne on your own...
- Älplermaggronen Dinner at the cabin Fluehmatt in Engelberg

Day 6 >> Fri.: (Engelberg - Domaso - Bologna)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Transfer by private bus during the day
- Visit to the "Azienda Agricole Sorsasso" for a wine tasting and to learn more about the history of their local products (Lombardy region) in the early afternoon
- 4 nights in twin bedded rooms with private bathrooms
incl. breakfast at a 3-star hotel in Bologna

Day 7 >> Sat.: (Bologna)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Gourmet walking tour of Bologna (during the tour you will stop at some food shops and taste local products) in the morning
- Afterwards, free time to explore Bologna on your own....

Day 8 >> Sun.: (Bologna)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Free day to explore Bologna on your own....

Day 9 >> Mon.: (Parma - Modena)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Transfer by private bus during the day
- Visit to a butcher specializing in Parmesan ham for demonstration & tasting in the morning
- Visit to Aceto del Duca in Modena in the afternoon. Learn more about the production of the traditional Aceto Balsamico di Modena
- Farewell Dinner at a restaurant in Bologna

Day 10 >> Tues.: (Bologna – Venice / Milan)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Transfer by private bus to the airport in Venice / Milan
- Departure from Venice / Milan Airport to the U.S. (airfare not included)

Also included in the price:

- Coordinator available during all planned excursions and activities while in Engelberg and Bologna
- **1 free place for the accompanying professor**

Price of the program:

€1,140 per person (*\$ 1,547) with a minimum number of 20 participants
