

Community Colleges for International Development (CCID) Study Abroad Program: **Hospitality Management and Culinary Arts Program**

A 10 day study abroad program in Europe:

The study abroad package includes:

Day 1 >> Mon.:

- Flight to Zurich, Switzerland (not included in the package price; optional: group flights can be arranged upon request)

Day 2 >> Tues.: (Zurich - Freiburg - Strasbourg)

- Arrival at Zurich Airport
- Transfer by private bus from the airport to Strasbourg with a stop-over in Freiburg (Zurich – Freiburg: approx. 2 hours and Freiburg – Strasbourg: approx. 1.5 hours)
- Guided walking tour of the university town of Freiburg to get a first impression of Europe
- Afterwards or before some free time for lunch at own expense (depends on flight)
- 2 nights in twin bedded rooms with shared bathrooms incl. breakfast at the CEPA study center “Château de Pourtalès” in Strasbourg, France
- Welcome reception at the Château to learn more about the Château and how it received “3 stars” for its hotel at the Châlet
- Dinner at the Château’s restaurant and Winstub “Le Jardin du Pourtalès”

Day 3 >> Wed.: (Strasbourg)

- Breakfast at the Château
- Transfer by private bus during the day
- Guided walking tour of Strasbourg in the morning to get a first impression of the city
- Guest lecture by representative of Strasbourg’s Tourist Office in the afternoon
- BBQ Dinner at the Château’s InteractionPark (incl. an introduction of the BBQ philosophy)

Day 4 >> Thurs.: (Strasbourg – Alsace - Engelberg)

- Breakfast at the Château
- Transfer by private bus during the day
- Visit to 4 or 5 star hotel in the Alsatian region in the morning
- Drive along the Alsatian Wine route with a stop-over at an Alsatian winery (incl. wine tasting)
- 5 nights in twin bedded rooms with shared bathrooms incl. breakfast at Hotel Europe in Engelberg
- Dinner at Hotel Europe

Day 5 >> Fri.: (Engelberg - Lucerne)

- Breakfast at Hotel Europe
- Transfer by private bus during the day
- Visit to a 5-star hotel in Lucerne incl. a behind the scene tour of the hotel and their restaurant in the morning
- Visit to a culinary school near Lucerne in the afternoon

Day 6 >> Sat.: (Engelberg)

- Breakfast at Hotel Europe
- Visit to the cheese dairy at Gerschnialp in the morning
- Free time afternoon to explore Engelberg and Swiss Alps (Mount Titlis) on your own...

Day 7 >> Sun.: (Engelberg - Lucerne)

- Breakfast at Hotel Europe
- Train ticket to Lucerne and return (travel time: approx. 1 hour one-way)
- Guided tour of the Convention Center Lucerne (KKL) in the morning
- Afterwards, free time to have dinner at own expense in Lucerne...
- Late-evening return to Engelberg

Day 8 >> Mon.: (Engelberg)

- Breakfast at Hotel Europe
- Guest lecture on "Marketing of Engelberg and Switzerland as a Tourist Destination" by a speaker of the Engelberg Tourist Office in the morning
- Behind the scene tour of Hotel Europe and its restaurant during the afternoon; Additional discussion with Chef about menu and selection preferred
- Älplermagronen Dinner at the cabin Fluehmatt in Engelberg to bid-farewell to Engelberg

Day 9 >> Tues.: (Zurich)

- Breakfast at Hotel Europe
- Transfer by private bus during the day
- Guided tour of the 5-star Hotel Widder in the morning
- Afterwards, free time for sight seeing and last-minute shopping in Zurich...
- Farewell Dinner at a restaurant in Zurich in the evening (before a behind the scene tour with the Chef or restaurant manager)
- Late check-in: 1 night in twin bedded rooms with private bathrooms incl. breakfast at a 2-star hotel in Zurich

Day 10 >> Wed.: (Zurich)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Transfer by private bus to the airport
- Departure from Zurich Airport to the USA (airfare not included)

Also included in the price:

- Coordinator during the entire trip
- **1 free place for the accompanying professor**
- Free use of computers and wifi at the Château de Pourtalès

Itinerary is subject to change according to availability

Price of the program:

€1,190 per person (*\$ 1,628) with a minimum number of 15 participants

€1,060 per person (*\$ 1,450) with a minimum number of 20 participants

The program price is per person and based on the stated minimum number of paying participants. One additional place is calculated free of charge in this price.

Not included in the price: roundtrip airfare, meals other than those above, gratuities to guides and drivers, passport expenses, insurances and personal expenses.
